

50 BR at Mission District Rod and Gun Club: Match Date Jun 28, 2014 (by Jim Latham)

For a few years Mission has had an active BR 50 Club that has used the ARA 25 bull targets and we shoot four of them for most matches, so we have 100 round score matches. The discipline has had a solid core of shooters but recently it has become increasingly popular. With only 12 benches and recent success we now have to run two relays.

After a somewhat rough start with our first real two relay match last month, this time under the Match Director Dave Harris, and watched over by BR50 Guru and undisputed Master Marksman Bob Goehring we had a superbly organized match which allowed us to be complexly finished, scored, fed, coffee'd and BS'd by 12:00 noon, a real accomplishment. Our first relay included the set up folks and scoring team so we were able to keep up with all the tasks of running the match. The second relay cleaned up well and as usual we left the range in better shape than it was before we started.

Conditions today were interesting. It was warm, about 20 degrees, muggy and mostly cloudy with light winds but these were constantly changing in direction. Wind flags over the 50 yards were often pointing in completely different directions. It was very difficult to wait for a condition- you pretty much had to know where you would aim in about 3 conditions. We have two classes; unlimited benchrest that allows any rest (several folks use one piece) and Sporter which are factory rifles shot off bi pods. You will see in the results that some of these sporter results place right in with the Benchrest scoring

The Benchrest Class winner today was Gord Park. We were glad to see him back after a long bout with health issues that kept him from shooting. He left us all in the dust. Ray Parkin topped a very competitive Sporter class.

Next match is Saturday July 26th. We set up at 8:00, commence the first relay at 9:00 and are all done and away by noon. If you are interested in the sport check out the MDRGC Website, and check the link under "Rifle" for more information.
