Rule Book

ARTICLE I

Official Rule Book

- Section 1. The approved rule book of reference for BRSC matches will be the NBRSA (National Bench Rest Shooters Association) rule book.
- Section 2. All Registered BRSC matches will be shot under the umbrella of this approved rule book.
- Section 3. The rule book is a guideline, and may be subject to the interpretation of the appointed match Officials. The decisions of the match Officials are final. Appeals to these decisions can be made in writing to the BRSC Executive.
- Section 4. BRSC will utilize the following sections of the NBRSA rule book as outlined below.
- (a) Sections A to I inclusive (pgs. 1-55) of the rule book, with the Amendments listed in Article III Section 2 (a)-(f) of this document.
 - (b) Sections J to N inclusive (pgs. 55-83) are not required at this time.
 - (c) Section O, Articles I-XI (pgs. 87-115) will remain but the NBRSA By-Laws (Articles I-XI) will be replaced with the BRSC By-Law documents.
 - (d) Sections P and Q (pgs. 117-118) will be honoured as outlined in the rule book.

ARTICLE II

Purpose

- Section 1. The use of an Official rule book is to fulfill the objectives outlined in Article II Section 2 of the BRSC By-Laws.

ARTICLE III

Amendments

- Section 1. Amendments to the rule book will be made in writing to the members of the Board of Directors, stating the substance of the proposed Amendment. Proposed Amendments will only be considered from a member (s) in good standing with BRSC. Amendments may be acted upon at any meeting of the membership and achieving a majority vote of the membership present or by mail ballot provided the substance of the proposed amendment shall have been stated in the notice and members given 21 days notice in advance of the proposed amendment.
- Section 2. Current Amendments to the rule book are as follows,

- (a) Where the terms National Bench Rest Shooters Association (NBRSA) are used insert the term Bench Rest Shooters Canada (BRSC).
- (b) Section A; Objectives of the NBRSA, (pg.11) Replace that section with Article II Sections 1-4 of the BRSC By-Laws.
- (c) Section C; Targets, Sub section 7 (pg. 19) Stationary Backers, This section will be omitted in its entirety.
- (d) Section D; Tournament Rules, Sub sections 2 & 3 (pg.19/20) Approval of Tournament dates, Replace "Regional Director" with "Records Chairman". Sub section 14 (pg.27-30) Procedure for Official Recognition of World Record; Replace that section in its entirety with the Procedure for BRSC Record Recognition as outlined in the document.
- (e) Section F; Tournament Procedure, sub section 1 (pg.35) Registration, Remove the sentence "New shooters may shoot their first match without being a BRSC member". Sub section 2 (pg.35) Registration Fees, Replace (a), (b), (c) with the BRSC Fee Schedule. Sub section 4 (pg.37) Pre Registration, Delete that section in its entirety. Sub section 10 (pg.41) Appointment of Tournament Officials, Delete item (d).
- (f) Section I; Host Club, sub section 2, (pg. 53) National Trophies, Replace the words "Nationals Trophies" with the words "BRSC Canadian Nationals Trophies. Replace the words "The Host Club" with "BRSC".
