After cancelling the January match due to anticipated nasty road conditions (which turned out to be a gross exaggeration) there was a pent up desire to shoot among our group and we had a full house, plus one, so we are going to have to plan for the possibility of two relays in the future. Our thanks to John de Best who helped out instead of shooting. The week had been glorious with some days reaching well into the teens and sunny, but of course Sunday turned out cold, wet and windy. That deterred no one and everyone who committed to attend was there. We decided that since we are planning to host a "major" group match in May, we need to start practicing that discipline as well, so we shot four group targets and followed with four VFS targets, all at 100 yards. Joe Mendham only shot group, scoring that while we shot VFS so we would not be there all afternoon waiting to see how we did. Scoring Group takes much longer than scoring VFS. So thanks for doing that Joe. Of course he won the Group as we expected!

And speaking of special thanks, after two full years of running the target set up and takedown, Art Harder has done yeoman service and deserves a break, and starting next match we will be assigning that job on a rotation basis. Many folks helped in one way or another like Sue, Len, John, Frank, Sam, etc. It takes preparation, planning, coordination and volunteer help to have 13 shooters complete 40 score rounds between 9:00 and 11:15 AM and be in the warm clubhouse by 11:30. We are efficient, maybe more so when it is miserable!

The conditions were challenging. There was a lot of rain and the winds were strong enough at times, especially later, to have the ribbons at about 50 degrees and as usual with Mission, due to the combination of switching and berms, they were not easy to read. The usual direction was from about 4 o'clock but that switched once in a while to about 8 o'clock. That would have been okay but many times the flags were showing both directions at the same time, but not consistently across the range. This was a time where watching your own flags and those around was very important. Some of us got it right much of the time and everyone got it some of the time, but nobody got it right all of the time.

Ray Parkin, who just joined us in the factory class, and actually shot handloads for the first time, did very well, winning both VFS and Group. And Mark Dumont, one of a few of our folks with considerable lathe skills shot his new toy very well, fire forming yet, his 30 ARX, 30 Major, it has a couple of names. It's made from the 6.5 Grendel necked up to 30 caliber and is much like the 100 yard group record caliber set by Mike Stinnett in 2013.
