The organizing committee has arranged for the following accommodation. Naturally competitors are free to stay wherever they like. The following hotels have given a preferred rate to competitors.

<p>Four Points Sheraton Located on western most point in Calgary, good accessibility to high way to range.</p>	<p>Preferred rate can be found on the attached rate sheet. Note this hotel will be the site of the Meet and Greet function, and is in very close proximity to the Canada Olympic Park venue which will be the site of the closing banquet. This hotel will also be a pickup and dropoff spot on the spouse tours.</p>
<p>Best Western Plus Located a little farther in the city than the Sheraton. Close to highway to range. About an extra 10-15 minute drive to the range as compared to the Sheraton.</p>	<p>Preferred rate and booking instructions can be found on the attached rate sheet. Rates are a bit better than Sheraton rates.</p>
<p>Aloft This is close to the University of Calgary and will add about 10 -15 minutes to the drive to the range as compared to the Sheraton.</p>	<p>Preferred rates and booking instructions can be found on attached rate sheet. Aloft offers a little more up market experience than the Sheraton or the Best Western.</p>
<p>Windtower – Canmore About the same distance of the range, about a 45 minute drive to Calgary for the Meet and Greet and the Closing Banquet.</p>	<p>Preferred rates and booking instructions can be found on the attached rate sheet. This hotel is located in the mountains, in the town of Canmore. This will appeal to shooters looking to stay in a mountain resort and in close proximity to the town of Banff. 1hr drive to Meet and Greet and Closing Banquet.</p>

Camping Option A The Calgary Campground	http://www.calgarycampground.com/ This campground is on the West edge of the city and in very close proximity to the Meet and Greet location, and Closing Banquet, and the Sheraton Hotel. It is a fully serviced campground and bookings for 2019 the season open in November 2018.
Camping Option B Pine Grove – Group Use	This is a group use campground that is in very close proximity to the range. Only about a 5 mile or 9 km drive to the range. Great for people looking for a wilderness camping experience. Lots are un-serviced, no power, no water or septic hookups. We will have mobile trucks service the campground as required with septic and water. You will need a generator. About a 45 minute drive to Meet and Greet and Closing Banquet.
