

Motion to revise WBC Qualifying – Oct. 20, 2013

In regards to individual qualifying for WBC events, should there be more candidates than WBC allocated team positions; the committee recommends that a formal qualifying program be implemented.

This qualifying program will consist of candidates accumulating points by attending Benchrest group matches in the qualifying year, which is the year prior to the WBC events. Candidates will be ranked by their accumulated points, with the final team selection conducted in accordance to this ranking. Those unable to attend the WBC event will be replaced by the next highest ranking candidates.

Qualifying Program:

- Competitors may select their best 6 Grand Aggregates of the year.
- All matches are eligible, with a special note that for the Kelbly Super Shoot, only finishing places 1 through 125 in the Grand Aggregates are eligible for points.
- LV, HV, Sporter Grand Aggregates are eligible.
- 1 point is awarded for each competitor the candidate places above in the Grand Aggregate.
- It is the responsibility of each candidate to submit their official match results to the WBC delegate for inclusion in the qualifying program.
- A final tally of accumulated points will be made available by year end of the qualifying year.
- Ties between two candidates will be determined by who had the smallest Grand Aggregate of the 6 chosen Grand Aggregates, with the smaller Grand Aggregate taking the higher qualifying position.
